The civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari directing the respondents to treat the petitioners in service w.e.f. the date of their initial appointment for the purpose of granting them pension and pensionary benefits under the provisions of Vol.II of Punjab Civil Services Rules as applicable to the State of Haryana and directing the respondents not to treat the petitioners under contributory pension scheme introduced by the State Government of Haryana.

The petitioners are seeking for alteration of date of regularisation in service. During the pendency of the litigation, the official respondents have passed the order changing the date of regularization as on 01.08.2016. In view of the said order, the petition do not survive for consideration.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that petitioners are entitled for service benefits including pensionary benefits of pay.

In this regard, petitioners are at liberty to make representation before the competent authority. If such a representation is submitted, the concerned respondent is hereby directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass a speaking order and communicate the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

The civil writ petition stands disposed of.
