By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reimburse the actual medical claim of the petitioner amounting to 3,50,000/- approximately, alongwith interest on the delayed payments @18% per annum.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a legal notice dated June 26, 2017 (Annexure P-4) was served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the

legal notice dated June 26, 2017 (Annexure P-4) and to take a conscious decision in view latest instructions issued by Government time to time and after considering the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No. 1523 of 2011 titled as **Om Parkash vs. State of Haryana & others;** decided on February 07, 2013, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case respondent No.3 comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the relief(s) claimed by him, to release the same within next 45 days. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
