The petitioner has approached under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, directing the respondents to cancel the Tender dated 15.09.2017 (Annexure P-7), which has been wrongly allotted to M/s Nanu Ram & Company, Jind. A further writ of *mandamus* has been sought for directing the official respondents to consider and evaluate the tender of the petitioner in accordance with the detail Tender Information (Annexure P-1) for the Session 2017-18 for sugarcane loading & transportation from Out Cane purchase and fulfilled all requirements as per terms and conditions of Tender Information.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that inadvertently, M/s Nanu Ram & Company, Jind, to whom according to the petitioner, work has been allotted, has not been impleaded as respondent(s).

Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action after proper impleadment.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
