This petition has been filed for directing the respondents to step up the pay of the petitioners at par with their juniors i.e. from the date their junior were getting higher salary/pay than the petitioners with all consequential benefits and quashing the action of respondents by which the petitioners are discriminated by not granting the benefits which juniors are getting.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioners have also moved legal notices (Annexure P-4 to P-21) to the respondents and at this stage they would be satisfied if these legal notices are decided

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notices of the petitioners and take necessary action thereon within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
