By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Principal w.e.f. the date when his juniors were promoted and have been allowed antedated promotion vide order dated April 28, 2015 (P-6) with all consequential benefits with further direction to revise the pension and pensionary benefits of the petitioner after allowing him anti-dated promotion to the post of Head Mast as well as Principal as has been allowed to similar situated employees vide order dated April 28, 2015 (P-6).

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that a representation dated November 17, 2013 (P-5) was made to Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Secondary Education Department, Civil Secretariat,

Chandigarh but till date nothing has been done. Even, though a legal notice dated June 23, 2017 (Annexure P-7) was also served upon the respondents, which has neither fetch any reply nor any benefit has been released to the petitioner so far. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.1 to consider and dispose of the legal notice (Annexure P-7) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated June 23, 2017 (Annexure P-7) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
