Petitioner seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus by directing respondents No. 4 to 8 not to interfere in the business trade of petitioner for loading/unloading/transporting the goods.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the directions have been given by the High Court on earlier occasions to the District Police authorities for ensuring that no obstruction/interference is caused by the Truck Union in lawful performance of the contractual work by the similarly circumstanced firm.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation Annexure P-2 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna for enforcement of the legal rights.

The interest of justice would be adequately met in case a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to get the controversy raised in Annexure P-2 looked into within a period of two months after the receipt of certified copy of this order and take appropriate decision taking into consideration the directions of the High Court.

It will be the duty of the petitioner to communicate the order to the concerned authority by supplying the certified copy.

Disposed of with above observation.
