JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the suspension allowance w.e.f. 1997 to 2003, pension and commuted pension and gratuity along-with interest @18% per annum.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to re-consider the legal notice dated January 05, 2017 (Annexure P-1) and dispose of the within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to re-consider the case of the petitioner as projected in the legal notice dated January 05, 2017 (Annexure P-1) and to take a conscious decision

by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, service rules, regulations and instructions issued by the government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, that too after giving a patient hearing to the petitioner. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
