The petitioner has prayed for a direction to respondents No.1 to 6 to restrain respondents No.8 to 16 from extorting money from it and interfering in his business.

This kind of a prayer cannot be granted in the writ petition as the petitioner has a remedy of filing civil suit seeking injunction against the persons or entities, who are interfering in its business, and can also resort to the procedure of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for registration of the FIR against such persons, if they are violating its civil rights.

With these observations, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
