In all these three petitions, the petitioners are seeking that the 'interview list' (Annexure P-5 annexed with CWP no.21728 of 2017), be quashed and the petitioners instead be called for interview on the basis of their marks obtained in the written examination, adding thereto the marks assignable to them on the basis of the experience gained by them, the criteria for selection including specific number of marks to be assigned for each year of experience gained by a candidate on the post of Shift

Attendants.

Similar petitions have already been allowed by this Court on 14.09.2017, for the reasons given in the orders passed in those petitions, the lead case being CWP no.18921 of 2017.

Consequently, these petitions are disposed of in the same terms, with the directions issued in the aforesaid order of this Court to apply to the case of the present petitioners also, after considering the marks assignable to them for the experience that they have gained in terms of their respective experience certificates annexed with their applications.

If the petitioners make it to the 'cut off marks' obtained by the last candidate already call for interview, the petitioners would also be interviewed.
