The prayer made in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 04.01.2017 (**Annexure P-3**) passed by respondent No.2 vide which it was ordered to take the possession of the residential property belongs to respondents No.7 and 8 with the help of police protection whereby the present petitioner is residing with his family as tenant since 2012. Further prayer has also been made to direct respondent No.2 to pass a fresh order after giving the proper opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and not to dispossess him from the residential premises.
