Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per letter issued by the Secretary, Subordinate Services Selection Board, Punjab, total 19 posts were advertised, five candidates of general category did not join and 11 posts of Assistant Treasurer in general category are still available.

In order dated 22.05.2017, it was mentioned that the petitioner had worked with the Bank from 17.06.2009 till 18.06.2012 and was having three years experience of handling cash. The claim of the petitioner was not considered only on the ground that the petitioner was not having experience of handling of cash, whereas a certificate was issued by the Bank that the petitioner was having experience of handling of cash. Meaning thereby, the petitioner fulfils the criteria of experience also.

Accordingly, the respondents are directed to consider the claim of the petitioner against vacant posts as the petitioner has obtained 40.5 marks and the last candidate has obtained 31.25 marks.

The necessary exercise be done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of order.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
