In the instant writ petition, petitioner has sought for a direction to the respondent to count past service rendered by him in the Punjab Engineering College as a Lecturer in Production Engineering during the period from 24.04.1992 to 17.01.1996 and to the extent the benefit of Senior Scale w.e.f. 27.07.1998, selection grade w.e.f. 27.07.2003 with all consequential benefits including arrears of pay with interest @ 18% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out from the Scheme of Revision of pay scales of Teachers, Physical Education and Library Personnel etc. Para 5 relates to career advancement. Para 9 relates to counting of past service. For the purpose of counting ad hoc service in

various colleges further requirement is ad hoc service should be of more than one year duration, the incumbent was appointed on the recommendation of duly constituted Selection Committee and was selected to the regular/permanent post in continuation of the ad hoc service, without any break. The petitioner is permitted to make necessary representation with material in respect of satisfying the above 3 conditions for the purpose of extending the benefit of senior scale and selection grade within a period of 2 weeks from today. Thereafter, the 2nd respondent is hereby directed to pass a speaking order whether the petitioner is entitled to senior scale and selection grade w.e.f. 27.07.1998 and 27.07.2003 respectively. If the petitioner satisfies the conditions in that event the aforesaid relief shall be extended to the petitioner within a period of 4 weeks from the receipt of the petitioner's representation.

With the above observation, CWP stands disposed of.
