In view of the categoric stand taken by the petitioner-College that there is full compliance of the deficiencies reiterated by the Central Government in the impugned order dated 31.08.2017 (P-9), its learned counsel seeks to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to approach the Competent Authority-Central Government to reconsider the decision dated 31.08.2017 and hold a fresh inspection of the College to satisfy itself that all the deficiencies have been removed. It is urged that such recourse would enable the petitioner-College to have permission to admit the students in the session 2017-18.

The writ petition is thus dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Competent Authority-Central Government. We have no reason to doubt that the petitioner's representation shall be considered by the Competent Authority objectively and at the earliest.
