Through instant writ petition, the petitioner has sought a direction to respondent No. 4 to file status report in FIR No. 39 dated 26.02.2015 under Sections 452/427/447/506/380/148/149 (Annexure P-2) and to proceed with the matter in accordance with order Annexure P-6 dated 28.03.2016 passed by respondent No. 3, the Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

Though the petitioner does not have a legally enforceable right to file a writ petition to determine the status of an FIR but the learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Paramjit Singh informs that in the above said FIR, two persons have already been apprehended and three accused have been granted the interim relief and that the investigation in the FIR is still in progress and has been transferred to Amritsar.

In view of above said circumstances, there does not appear to be any ground to issue any directions to the investigating agency lest it should interfere in the process of investigation.

Expecting that the investigation would be conducted fairly,  
the petition is disposed of as having outlived its utility.
