After hearing the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner, it appears that no cause of action has arisen to file the present petition as the petitioner-Society has approached this Court only on the basis of apprehension that disciplinary action can be initiated as mentioned in letter dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-10).

Admittedly, reply of the letter has been filed, which is on record as Annexure P-12 but no action has been taken. This petition is pre-mature as no order has been passed and as such no cause of action has arisen to the petitioner. The petition is not maintainable.

However, keeping in view the apprehension of the petitioner, it is mentioned that in case, any action is to be taken against the petitioner-Society then reply filed by the petitioner as Annexure P-12 be taken into consideration.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
