DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that C.W.P. No. 11253 of 2017 and other connected cases were fixed for hearing before this Court on 25.9.2017 and the same were disposed of. The case of the petitioners is also similar and the present petition may also be disposed of in terms of decision rendered in the aforesaid case.

The relevant portion of order dated 25.9.2017 passed in C.W.P. No. 11253 of 2017 and other connected cases is reproduced as under:-

“I have noticed that the first writ petition in respect of these four questions was allowed as far as back in 2016. There is no reason why this general relief was not granted to all similarly situated candidates which has resulted in a situation where hundreds of candidates have been filing writ petitions for the same relief and each one of them individually is disposed of in

terms of the original decision.

In the circumstances, it is directed that the respondents shall now review the answers of all the examinees and give necessary benefit of these four wrong questions to all of them who are entitled for the same without waiting for them to file writ petitions. Since this entire process has to be done electronically and since the State of Punjab has advertised posts of teachers for which the last date of application is 6.10.2017 this exercise be now conducted on or before 3.10.2017.

All the petitions stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be handed over to the learned Assistant Advocate General under the signature of the Bench Secretary.”

In view of the above, the present petition is also disposed of in terms of decision in C.W.P. No. 11253 of 2017 (**Jaspreet Kaur and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**) decided on 25.9.2017.
