The only prayer made by the petitioner in the present petition is for a direction to the respondents to pay compensation on account of acquisition of land.

Briefly, the facts of the case are that vide notification dated 29.11.2001, issued under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short, 'the Act'), State of Haryana sought to acquire land, situated in villages Rashoi Hadbast No. 42, Nangal Kala Hadbast No. 43, Kundli Hadbast No. 55 and Nathupur Hadbast No. 56, Tehsil and District Sonapat for development and utilization thereof as residential and commercial Sector 58, Sonapat. The same was followed by notification dated 28.11.2002 issued under Section 6 of the Act. The Land Acquisition Collector (for short, 'the Collector'), vide award dated 24.11.2004, assessed the market value of the acquired land.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Jagbir

Singh, Kanungo, Land Acquisition Officer, Rohtak, submitted that after the

petitioner furnishes details of his bank account number and his identity proof, the amount, as awarded by the Collector, will be deposited in account of the petitioner within one week thereafter.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that though the aforesaid documents have already been furnished, however, still the petitioner will furnish a fresh copy thereof to the Collector at Sonapat.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of. The petitioner may furnish fresh copies of his bank account particulars and the identity proof with the Collector at Sonapat. On furnishing thereof, within one week thereafter, the amount of compensation as determined by the Collector shall be deposited in the account of the petitioner.
