The petitioner was aspirant for admission in MBBS Course as per her merit in NEET-2017, but she could not make it during the first and second counseling conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot-respondent No.2. The petitioner thereafter appeared in physical counseling (Mop Up Round) held on 31.08.2017. Her allegations are that despite availability of seats and her turn having come, she was denied admission arbitrarily.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

We are afraid, the petitioner's grievance cannot be entertained at this belated stage when admissions to MBBS Course in all circumstance are over due to expiry of cut-off date. The petitioner had a chance to appear before University authorities on 04.09.2017 also but there is no convincing explanation for that. The writ petition suffers from delay and laches as the petitioner had sufficient time to approach the Court immediate after 31.08.2017. No effective relief can be granted to her at this stage by this Court or by the respondent-University.

Dismissed.
