As per pleadings on record, petitioners had applied for the post of Revenue Patwaries/Canal Patwaries under the Ex-servicemen General Category in pursuance to a recruitment process initiated vide advertisement dated 10.09.2016.

It is the contention raised by counsel that all the petitioners herein, had participated in the process of selection and even though, their names did not figure in the final select list but they were wait-listed.

The entire case sought to be projected by counsel is that a number of posts in the category to which the petitioners belong, have remained vacant on account of non-joining of the selected candidates and accordingly, the petitioners would be vested with a right to be offered such vacant posts.

Such prayer cannot be accepted and examined for the

reason that the pleadings are completely bereft as regards the merit secured by the petitioners herein and their precise place and ranking in the wait list.

Confronted with such a situation, counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to file a petition afresh with better and necessary particulars in the light of the observations made herein.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
