After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in this petition the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 16.09.2016 (Annexure P-9) which has not been decided despite lapse of one year and at this stage he would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

Learned Assistant Advocate General states that this would be a fair order.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
