Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 12.11.2014 passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala with reference to the eligibility of the beneficiaries for allotment of five marla plots. The order was passed on 12.11.2014. The writ petition was moved two years thereafter in November, 2016.

While passing the order, the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala has recorded definite findings that out of 76 allottees only three were found eligible as per the instructions issued by the Government. The persons who were found ineligible were either land owners or were living as heads of the families or having their own dwelling houses and four had died even before the allotments were made.

The committee, which was constituted to examine the allotment of plots, has recommended to review the previous resolution.

Considering the fact that the Deputy Commissioner finding discrepancies in the allotment of plots has referred the matter back to the Committee for reconsideration, we do not find any merit in the present petition. The same is accordingly dismissed.
