This petition has been filed for quashing the impugned orders dated 18.08.2009 passed by respondent No.3 by which no benefit of stepping up has been granted to the petitioners and further directing the respondents to step up the pay of the petitioners at par with the pay of their counterparts w.e.f. the date of their joining with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioners have also moved an advance notice (Annexure P-10) to the respondents and at this stage they would be satisfied any decision is taken thereon by

the respondent No.2 within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said notice of the petitioners by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
