By this petition the petitioner has complained about the fact that it had issued a legal notice and the respondent No.2-The State Transport Commissioner had directed the respondent No.3-Regional Transport Authority, Jalandhar to decide the same by letter dated 08.09.2017. Thereafter, the area where the petitioner is operating fell to the jurisdiction of the newly created respondent No.4 and consequently the petitioner is apprehensive that its legal notice (Annexure P-3) may end up not being decided at all.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.4-The Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Gurdaspur to decide the said legal notice expeditiously by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order by giving reasons.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc.
Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
