DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that similarly situated employees filed ***CWP No.17640 of 2015*** and the same was disposed of in terms of order passed in ***CWP No.12023 of 2015***.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, the same directions are issued in this case also.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners in terms of order passed in ***CWP o.12023 of 2015*** within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioners are found to be entitled for the relief sought for in the legal notice, which is annexed as Annexure P-5 with the petition, the same be granted to them within a period of two months thereafter.

However, in case, the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner, they are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
