The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to issue refund of ₹ 2,82,362/- which has been found refundable to the petitioner while passing rectification order for assessment year 2013-14 (**Annexure P-3**) dated 27.06.2017 along with interest as prescribed under the law.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submitted that the relief regarding refund as claimed in the writ petition, has since been granted to the petitioner and the present petition has been rendered infructuous. Accordingly, a prayer was made that the present writ petition may be disposed of as such.
