In this petition, the petitioner has made a prayer for seeking a direction to respondent no.2, i.e. Director General of Police, Punjab, to register an FIR against respondents no.3 to 6.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and examining the available record, I am of the considered opinion that the job of registration of FIR is of the Station House Officer concerned, as enshrined under Section 154 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. However, from the record, I have found that the petitioner has not approached the Station House Officer concerned for the purpose of registration of FIR.

Be that as it may, the petitioner may, if so advised, file an application to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, for the purpose of registration of FIR and in case any such application is filed, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga is directed to look into that application and pass necessary orders for the purpose of registration of FIR, if any case is made out.
