Petitioners seek the benefit of regularization in service.

Case set up is that the petitioners were engaged as Multipurpose Health Worker (Female)/ANM in the year 2008 under the Scheme of 2211-Head, which is a State Cadre having sanctioned posts sponsored by the Central government in the respondent-Health and Family Welfare Department, State of Punjab

Learned counsel representing the petitioners would contend that the initial engagement of the petitioners was in pursuance to a transparent and regular selection process and the petitioners had possessed the essential qualifications stipulated in the advertisement issued at that point of time and which are *paramateria* to the statutory Rules framed thereafter i.e. the Punjab Health and Family Welfare Technical (Group-C) Service Rules, 2016.

It is contended that the claim of the petitioners seeking regularization would be covered in terms of Section 3 of the Punjab Ad hoc, Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work-charged and Outsourced Employees Welfare Act, 2016.

Without commenting on the merits of the claim set up, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Director, Health Services (Family Welfare), Punjab to examine the claim of the petitioners strictly in accordance with law and to take a final decision on the legal notice dated 31.07.2017 (Annexure P-6) i.e. stated to have already been served within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
