The petitioner applied for revalidation of the allotment of HIG Flat in Sector 44-D, Chandigarh. The Chandigarh Housing Board by a letter dated 03.08.2017 stated that the request of the petitioner is neither considered nor rejected.

The writ petition is, therefore, premature. The communication dated 03.08.2017 states that no decision has yet been taken on the petitioner's application. The petitioner must, therefore, pursue his application further. He is always at liberty to challenge the decision if it is adverse to him.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as premature.

The respondents shall at this stage inform the petitioner about the status of his case only.
