The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, quashing the order dated 08.06.2017 (Annexure P-10). A further writ of *mandamus* has been sought for directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to run the liquor vends at a distance of 220 metres from the edge of the Highways in the areas, where the population is 20,000 or less in compliance with the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that certain relevant documents could not be appended and averments in that regard incorporated in the present writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action by furnishing correct

and better particulars.
