today.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of at this stage as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to challenge any adverse order passed by respondent No.1 with a direction to the respondent No.2 to inform the petitioner about the decision of the respondent No.1 immediately on receipt.
