The instant writ petition was filed seeking to challenge the advertisement No.1 of 2016 published on 31.05.2016, on a limited ground that while applying on-line, there was no provision for the petitioners to apply within the sub category of Ex-Serviceman SC.

After notice was issued in the petition, reply has been filed by way of an affidavit of Shri Gursharan Singh Sandhu, IPS, Deputy Inspector General of Police, Crime, Punjab-cum-Member Central Recruitment Board for Constables-2016, wherein it is stated that as per the revised merit list, both the petitioners have been selected. As regards petitioner No.1, he has been selected in Armed Police cadre in Ex-Servicemen SC (M&B) category, and petitioner No.2 has been selected in District Police cadre in Ex-Servicemen SC (M&B) category.

In view of the fact that both the petitioners herein have already been selected in the sub categories that they belong to, this instant writ petition is being disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
