Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the period of work charge services rendered by the petitioner with respondent-department from 01.06.1979 to 18.12.1991 for the purpose of pensionary benefits with all consequential benefits, in view of instructions issued by the Government from time to time.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a legal notice dated July 25, 2017 (P-2) was made to the respondents but no final decision has been taken by the concerned authorities till date.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels

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satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide his legal notice in a time bound manner.

4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated July 25, 2017 (Annexure P-2) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order that too, after giving a patience hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
