The petitioner claims that Khasra No.175 (1-2) is a Manure Pit and thus cannot be included in *shamlat deh*. The said khasra number therefore, does not vest in Gram Panchayat. A restrained order is thus sought from raising any construction on the said khasra number by the Gram Panchayat.

In our considered view, both these reliefs can be sought by the petitioner by way of a petition under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 or for the purpose of simple injunction, he may approach the Civil Court also.

With liberty aforementioned, we decline to entertain the instant writ petition.
