By virtue of the instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation dated 01.03.2017 (P-3) to acknowledge the claim of the petitioner for releasing the arrears of pension from the date of his retirement i.e. 30.04.2010 from the post of Naik by allowing condonation of shortfall/deficiency in service tenure of 3 months for completing 15 years for considering pensionable service of the petitioner with respondent-Department.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a representation dated March 01, 2017 (P-3) was made to the respondents but neither any reply has been received nor final decision has been taken by the concerned authorities till date.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide his representation in some prescribed period.

4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated March 01, 2017 (Annexure P-3) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order that too, after giving a patience hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
