By this petition the petitioners have complained about as what they called as exorbitant demand of fees by the respondent No.8-School.

Counsel for the petitioners states that in this connection the petitioners had moved a representation to the Fees & Fund Regulatory Committee – respondent No.4 among others as far back as on 08.06.2017 and thereafter various representations were also given but till date no action has been taken thereon. As per him the Rules 158-A and 158-B of the Haryana School Education Rules mandates the period of 60 days for the respondent No.4 to decide the issue but now a period of almost 120 days has passed.

In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to direct the

respondent No.4 to take action on the representations [Annexures P-6 (colly)] in accordance with Rules 158-A and 158-B of the Haryana School Education Rules. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
