The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the order dated 28.09.2017 (Annexure P-13) passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh (in short, 'the CAT'), in Misc. Application No.060/01455/2017 in OA No.060/01012/2017 and the office order dated 02.06.2017 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Audit Examination Officer, Part-3 and Examination o/o the Principal Accountant General (Audit), Haryana vide which the petitioner has been declined to sit in the Audit/Accounts Service Examination, which is scheduled to be held from 6th October, 2017. Further prayer has also been to direct the respondents to allow the petitioner to sit in the aforesaid Examination.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submitted that since the original application is pending before the CAT and is stated to be listed for hearing on 15.11.2017, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition.
