The petitioner is bringing his grievance being whistle blowers against respondent No.4-Sarpanch by making a complaint (Annexure P-4) to DDPO for taking immediate action against Baldip Kaur and her husband for illegal possession over panchayat land.

Reply given is that instructions for allotment of land by way of plots is in accordance with law, in essence, every Rule has been followed. Resolution in this regard has also been passed. However, during the pendency of the writ petition, Mr. Khunger, Advocate, vide miscellaneous application No.10005 of 2016, placed on record Annexure P-6 with regard to some illegal construction of three marlas of land raised by one Gurlal

Singh and his brother Tari Singh near the house of the present Sarpanch on the plot No.30//23 and the aforementioned letter reveals that Sarpanch has been directed to take action. Once the machinery has already been put in motion, no further cause of action survives.

Accordingly, present writ petition stands rendered dismissed as infructuous.
