The petitioner has approached this Court seeking to challenge acquisition of land. Notifications under Sections 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short, 'the Act'), was issued on 31.12.2013. The purpose for which the land was sought to be acquired is for the development and utilization of land for Industrial Estate, Phase-II, Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that notification under Section 6 of the Act was issued on 23.12.2014 and after reconsidering the entire matter, the Government has decided to drop the acquisition proposed to be carried out vide aforesaid notification.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the State, the prayer made in the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
