The challenge in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is to order dated 03.12.2013 (**Annexure P-11**) passed by the District Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib and the letter of the respondent-Bank addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib dated 04.08.2016 (**Annexure P-10**), thereby seeking police assistance for taking physical possession of the property in dispute.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the appropriate Forum to raise all the grievances as raised in the present writ petition, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
