This application is filed to place on record the pedigree table
(Annexure P-14) of Bhagail Singh.

Application is allowed.

CWP No.22723 of 2017

This petition is filed against the order dated 4.9.2017 passed by
the Financial Commissioner (Revenue) by which the petitioners have been
non-suited to claim the property of Chamel Kaur on the ground that they have
failed to prove their relation with her.

In the present case, an order was passed by this Court on
6.10.2017 to place on record the pedigree table of Chamel Kaur. Pursuant to
the said order, the petitioners have filed the application bearing CM No.15658
of 2017, along with the pedigree table in order to prove that they are the legal
heirs of Chamel Kaur.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after
examining the record, am of the considered opinion that the issue with regard

to the fact that the petitioners are the legal heirs of Chamel Kaur has to be determined by the Civil Court for which the petitioners had to file civil suit for declaration to get their rights declared about their relation with Chamel Kaur for the purpose of inheriting her property which was allegedly allotted to her in the year 1949.

With these observations, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
