This petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as Pipe Fitter and further to pay him the salary of the said post from retrospective effect with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has got issued legal notice (Annexure P-10) to the respondents and at this stage he would be satisfied if the legal notice is decided by the respondent No.4 within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the respondent No.4 to decide the said legal notice of the petitioner by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
