Grievance of the petitioners is that laxity in timely movement of food grains leads to sufferings of employees of the PUNSUP. Thus a mandamus be issued to the respondents to ensure that there is prompt action and timely movement of the food grains. Petitioners have already sent legal notice Annexure P/22 to the respondents.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that though necessary steps have already been taken, legal notice shall be looked into and disposed of after affording of opportunity of hearing to a representatives of the petitioners at the earliest in any case not later than 4 months.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary.
