Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in respect of his grievance of an adverse ACR having been recorded against him wrongly (as contended), for the periods 07.11.2011 to 31.03.2012 and 01.04.2012 to 01.08.2012, he has filed a representation which has still not been decided.

Consequently, though it is a 'mercy petition' which has been filed, which otherwise may not otherwise lie, however, learned counsel has stated that the petitioner has been exonerated by the Enquiry Committee headed by a DSP, of the charges levelled against him on account of which the adverse ACR was recorded.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, i.e. the Director General of Police, Haryana, to decide the aforesaid 'mercy petition' of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, keeping in view the aforesaid contentions made, as also what is stated in the petition itself, a copy of which is annexed as Annexure P-6 with present petition.
