The petitioner has filed the present petition seeking to challenge the acquisition of land, while placing reliance on the provisions of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (for short, 'the 2013 Act').

Briefly, the facts of the case are that vide notification dated 9.12.2013, issued under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short, 'the 1894 Act'), State of Haryana sought to acquire land, situated in villages Garauli Kalan and Basai, District Gurgaon. The same was followed by notification dated 5.12.2014, issued under Section 6 of the 1894 Act.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Rajinder

Singh Kanungo, Office of Land Acquisition Officer, Gurugram, submitted

that as the administrative approval for announcement of award for the acquired land of the petitioner was not granted by the State, the acquisition has lapsed.

In view of the stand taken by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
