The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari*, quashing the impugned order dated 25.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.5 and order dated 25.08.2015 (Annexure A-7) passed by respondent No.4.

2. It was submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the certain issues, which had been raised before the Central Administrative Tribunal (in short 'the Tribunal'), had not been discussed. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Tribunal for seeking review of the impugned order.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
