Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the marks assignable to the petitioners for the experience gained by them as per the criteria framed on that issue, by the respondent-Commission in its advertisement issued on 04.04.2016, Annexure P-1, have not been added to the marks obtained by them in the written test, after which the interview letter should have been issued taking into account the combined total of the aforesaid marks.

In similar matters, orders have been passed by this Court (in CWP no.18921 of 2017 and other connected matters), vide an order dated 14.09.2017, directing that the marks assignable for experience to any candidate should be added to the marks obtained by him in the written examination, both being “known invariables”.

Notice of motion be issued to the respondents.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. R.K. Doon, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

On query to Mr. R.K. Doon, learned counsel for the respondents, as to whether the interview process pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 14.09.2017 has been concluded or not, he has taken instructions to submit that it has not even commenced as yet.

Consequently, this petition is allowed in terms of the order dated 14.09.2017 passed in the aforesaid writ petitions, with the directions issued in those cases to apply to the case of the present petitioners also, upon the respondent-Commission determining as to whether they have obtained more marks than the last candidate called for an interview in the process of interviews that has already been concluded.

The directions be carried out at the earliest, so as to conclude the selection process as early as possible.
