Petitioner has posed a challenge to the order passed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Talwandi Sabo whereby petitioner has been asked to pay Rs.7000/-per month as maintenance to his mother. Order has been challenged on the ground that the authority did not appreciate the controversy in the correct perspective. There was possibility of amicable settlement which was not explored. I am not convinced with this arguments. Respondent No.3 filed an application submitting that she was being harassed by the petitioner. She did not have any source of income to meet day to day expenses. On due consideration of the matter, Sub Divisional Magistrate directed the petitioner to pay Rs.7000/- per month to his mother to meet her expenses. There is no legal infirmity with the order. Dismissed.
