The petitioner herein had applied for a post of Manager (Quality Control) for Markfed Cattlefeed and Allies Industries, Kapurthala. Apart from educational qualification he had five years experience in Pharmaceutical industry, however, in the final eligibility list prepared, the petitioner has not been found eligible for appointment.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the experience gained is similar to the job profile as sought by the respondents in their advertisement. The petitioner has already approached the concerned department for consideration for appointment by keeping in mind the experience that he has gained. However, to date the said representations have not been decided.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein is seeking a limited prayer that his representations be decided as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer made, without going into the merits of the case, this

petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to file a fresh representation within a period of two weeks along with the certified copy of this order. On receipt of the said representation, the respondent-department is directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two months thereafter.
