By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents to decide her representation (P-1) by passing a speaking order.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a representation dated July 12, 2017 (Annexure P-1) was moved to the respondent No.6 but till date, no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondents No. 4 & 5, to decide the representation, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.4 and 5 to look into the grievances unfolded by the

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petitioner in her representation dated July 12, 2017 (Annexure P-1) and take a conscious decision, as per Rules and Instructions within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order passed by concerned authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
