Petitioner has posed a challenge to the order passed by Lokayukta whereby complaint filed by the petitioner has been closed. Petitioner seeks action against the doctor and police officials, who are arrayed as respondent Nos. 2 to 8. On the last date of hearing, a copy of the petition was handed over to State counsel to enable him to assist the court. Today, he has apprised the court that there was an altercation between the two parties and cross cases were registered. Trial has culminated and in the said cases, accused have been convicted. According to him, thus, no cause of action survives in this petition. This court finds substance in the plea of State counsel. No ground to interfere in the writ jurisdiction is made out. Dismissed.
